## EMPLOYEE COVID GUIDELINES

\*TRUSD Student Covid Guidelines is based on COVID-19 Public Health Guidance for K-12 Schools to Support Safe In-Person Learning, 2022-2023 School Year (Effective August 8, 2022)

***This general reference guide is intended to provide the latest COVID-19 guidance for TRUSD employees.***

<b>Masks</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Masks are not required, strongly recommended</li> </ul>
<b>COVID Health Screening</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Employees are required to complete daily self-screening. If they have symptoms, they are strongly encouraged to stay home and complete a COVID test.</li> </ul>
<b>COVID Vaccination Status</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Vaccination is not required but strongly recommended</li> <li>○ Employee vaccination status must be reported to Superintendent</li> </ul>
	<b>You are UP-TO-DATE on your vaccination status if:</b>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Received a booster vaccine</li> <li>○ Recently vaccinated (received two doses of Pfizer/Moderna, one dose of J &amp; J) and not yet eligible for booster dose</li> <li>○ Wait time for booster:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Pfizer vaccine was at least 5 months ago</li> <li>- Moderna vaccine was at least 6 months ago</li> <li>- J &amp; J vaccine was at least 2 months ago</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
	<b>You are NOT UP-TO-DATE on your vaccination status if:</b>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>○ Have not received any COVID vaccines</li> <li>○ Have only received one dose of Pfizer/Moderna or it has not been 14 days since receiving last dose</li> <li>○ Received two doses of Pfizer/Moderna or one J &amp; J dose and are eligible for booster</li> <li>○ Booster eligibility:                             <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Pfizer vaccine was at least 5 months ago</li> <li>- Moderna vaccine was at least 6 months ago</li> <li>- J &amp; J vaccine was at least 2 months ago</li> </ul> </li> </ul>
<b>COVID Exposures</b>	<b>Everyone, regardless of vaccination status. *Note: Persons infected within the prior 90 days do not need to be tested.</b>
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Test within 3-5 days after last exposure</li> <li>▪ Strongly encourage to get vaccinated or boosted.</li> <li>▪ Per CDPH masking guidance, close contacts should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings</li> <li>▪ If symptoms develop, test and stay home.</li> </ul>
<b>COVID Positive Cases/ Isolation Period</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>▪ Isolation for at least 5 days</li> <li>▪ Isolation can end after day 5 (on day 6) if employee tests negative and no fever and symptoms have improved or are not present</li> <li>▪ If employee tests positive on day 5 or still has a fever, standard isolation period is 10 days</li> <li>▪ If an employee chooses <u>not to test</u> and their symptoms are not present or are resolving with no fever, isolation ends after day 10</li> <li>▪ Per CDPH masking guidance, infected persons should wear a well-fitting mask around others for a total of 10 days, especially in indoor settings</li> </ul>
