*TRUSD Student Covid Guidelines is based on COVID-19 Public Health Guidance for K-12 Schools to Support Safe In-Person Learning, 2022-2023 School Year (Effective August 10, 2022)

This general reference guide is intended to provide the latest COVID-19 guidance for TRUSD Students.

Mitigation	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Masks are optional ▪ No person can be prevented from wearing a mask as a condition of participation in an activity or entry into a school, unless wearing a mask would pose a safety hazard. ▪ Schools must provide masks to students who desire to use one ▪ Optimize indoor air quality ▪ Promote proper hand washing and hand hygiene 	
COVID Exposures	Student Exposed to COVID-19 in a K-12 school setting. (All students do not need to quarantine after exposure, if asymptomatic) Vaccination for all eligible students will be promoted by TRUSD.	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • More than a cumulative total of 15 minutes • Within 24 hours • In a shared indoor airspace 	GUIDELINES	ADDITIONAL INFORMATION
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students remain in school ▪ Students recommended to test on day 3-5 after last exposure 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Students may participate in any sport or extracurricular activity if asymptomatic ▪ Recommended to wear a well-fitting mask for a total of 10 days after last exposure
STUDENTS with new and unexplained symptoms	Students exhibiting symptoms will stay home until:	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ At least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever reducing medication and symptoms have improved ▪ Received a negative COVID test, OR ▪ A healthcare provider has provided medical documentation of their underlying chronic condition or an alternative named diagnosis 	
COVID Positive Cases/ Isolation Period	Students with COVID-19 regardless of vaccination status (Provide proof of positive COVID-19 test result to school site)	
	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ▪ Isolation for at least 5 days ▪ Isolation can end after day 5 (on day 6) if student tests negative and no fever and symptoms have improved or are not present ▪ If student tests positive on day 5 or still has a fever, isolation period continues until student tests negative or day 10 (return on day 11) ▪ If a student does <u>not test</u> and their symptoms are not present or are resolving with no fever, return on day 11 ▪ Earliest return is ALWAYS encouraged ▪ Masks recommended if student returns to school before day 11 	
COVID Guidelines for INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL	Students returning from International Travel must:
