This general reference guide is intended to provide the latest COVID-19 guidance for TRUSD Students.	
Mitigation	<ul> <li>Masks are optional</li> <li>No person can be prevented from wearing a mask as a condition of participation in an activity or entry into a school, unless wearing a mask would pose a safety hazard.</li> <li>Schools must provide masks to students who desire to use one</li> <li>Optimize indoor air quality</li> <li>Promote proper hand washing and hand hygiene</li> </ul>

	GUIDELINES  ■ Students remain in school ■ Students recommended to test on day 3-5 after last exposure ■ Recommended to wear a well-fitting mask for a total of 10 days after last exposure
STUDENTS with new and unexplained symptoms	Students exhibiting symptoms will stay home until:
	<ul> <li>At least 24 hours have passed since resolution of fever without the use of fever reducing medication and symptoms have improved</li> <li>Received a negative COVID test, OR</li> <li>A healthcare provider has provided medical documentation of their underlying chronic condition or an alternative named diagnosis</li> </ul>
<b>COVID Positive Cases/</b>	Students with COVID-19 regardless of vaccination status (Provide proof of positive COVID-19 test result to school site)
Isolation Period	<ul> <li>Isolation for at least 5 days</li> <li>Isolation can end after day 5 (on day 6) if student tests negative and no fever and symptoms have improved or are not present</li> <li>If student tests positive on day 5 or still has a fever, isolation period continues until student tests negative or day 10 (return on day 11)</li> <li>If a student does <u>not test</u> and their symptoms are not present or are resolving with no fever, return on day 11</li> <li>Earliest return is <b>ALWAYS</b> encouraged</li> <li>Masks recommended if student returns to school before day 11</li> </ul>
